5. To receive the Treasurer's Report and Financial Statement.
6. To receive the Report of the Charity Representative.
7. To ballot for, as a Candidate for initiation, Mr. Donald Sidney Griffiths, age 32 years, Managing Director, of High View, Wolverhampton Road, Kidderminster, proposed at the last Regular Meeting by Bro. D. Mole, S.W., and seconded by Wor. Bro. A. W. Mole, P.P.G.D.
8. To install the Master Elect, Bro. Daniel Mole, S.W., who will afterwards appoint and invest his officers.
9. To present a Past Master's Jewel to the retiring Worshipful Master.
10. To report on proceedings of Grand Lodge.
11. To receive propositions.
12. To receive subscriptions.
13. To transact any other business that may arise for the good of Freemasonry in general, or of this, the Regis Lodge No. 4463, in particular.
14. To close the Lodge.
