FIRST MEETING OF THE BOARD OF STEWARDS

At the meeting of the Board of Stewards held at Freemasons' Hall on Thursday, 25th June 1981 the following arrangements were made for the 194th Anniversary Festival.

PLACE AND TIME OF MEETING

The Festival is to be held at the Connaught Rooms, Great Queen Street, London, WC2B 5DA.

Dinner will be at 6.00 p.m. for 6.30 p.m. terminating at approximately 9.15 p.m.

DRESS

Full dress Masonic Craft Clothing (less cuffs) will be worn with Morning Dress (or dark suit). Black shoes, White Collar and Black Tie. The Festival Committee suggested that for Ladies 'Long or Short Dresses' would be particularly suitable.

STEWARDS' FEE AND DINING FEES

The respective Steward's Fee and Dining Fee have been fixed as follows:-

	Steward's Fee if not dining	If dining an additional payment of:
For Brethren (qualifying as Life-Governors with a donation of not less than £10.50)...	£1.50	£15.00
For Ladies (qualifying as Life-Governors with a donation of not less than £5.25)...	£1.50	£15.00
For Lewises - being Minors - (qualifying as Life-Governors with a donation of not less than £5.25).....	£1.50	

These fees are for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Festival. After these expenses have been met, any balance remaining is paid into the Funds of the Institution.

ALLOCATION OF SEATING

The Board of Stewards have, as usual, decided that seats for the Festival shall be allotted to Stewards only and shall, as far as practicable, be reserved in the order in which Dining Fees have been received in this Office.

DINNER TICKETS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Dinner Tickets, with full directions and details of the Festival Day arrangements, will be forwarded shortly before the Festival to all those Stewards who have paid their Dining Fees.

IMPORTANT

It is important, that for the smooth running of the Festival arrangements, the names of all dining and non dining Stewards should be notified to the Secretary of The Royal Masonic Institution for Girls.

The 1982 Steward's Badge will be issued to each Steward as early as possible after the receipt of the Steward's Fee. In the case of a Steward who has served a previous Stewardship for the R.M.I.G., a Bar for his Grand Lodge Charity Jewel will be issued (if he so requests) in lieu of the Festival Badge.

Should you not desire to receive either the Festival Badge or Bar, I should be grateful if you would indicate this on Form 'E'.

A copy of the R.M.I.G. 1982 Year Book will be presented to every Brother qualified as a Steward at the time of the Festival.
