## BY-LAWS

### ST. OSWALD CONCLAVE No. 278

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1. The Conclave shall meet at the Masonic Hall, Rainbow Hill, Worcester, on the fourth Wednesday in March, September and November at such time as the Sovereign may appoint.
2. The Sovereign, Viceroy and Treasurer shall be elected by ballot and two Auditors and the Sentinel by show of hands at the regular meeting in November. The Sovereign elect shall be enthroned and the Viceroy elect consecrated at the regular meeting in March, when the officers shall be appointed and the Treasurer elect and Sentinel elect invested.

3. The Treasurer shall receive all moneys which shall be deposited in the name of the Conclave in a bank approved by the Conclave, pay all accounts and shall present a balance sheet, which shall have been audited by the two elected members of the Conclave, at the regular meeting in March.
  
4. The names of the candidates proposed for election and of joining members shall be communicated to the Recorder at least one month before the meeting. Election shall be by ballot, and should two black balls appear the proposition shall be rejected, and shall not be renewed for at least twelve months. Each meeting shall be convened by summons issued by the Recorder at least seven days before the meeting.

5. The fee for installation shall be £6.00 which shall be inclusive of reception into the Orders of the Holy Sepulchre and St. John the Evangelist, but exclusive of the fees for the respective certificates. The fee for a joining member shall be £3.00. The yearly subscription shall be £5.00 due and payable in advance at the regular meeting in March. The summons for the March meeting shall include a notice that the subscription is due. Change of address should at once be notified to the Recorder.
6. Any questions arising which are not provided for by these by-laws shall be referred to a Committee consisting of The Sovereign, Viceroy, Treasurer, Recorder and Past Sovereigns of the Conclave. If any alteration or amendment of these by-laws is recommended, notice thereof shall be inserted in the summons convening the next meeting of the Conclave.

Such alteration or amendment must be approved by two-thirds of the members then present and voting. It shall not be effective until approved by the Intendant General and by the M. Ill Grand Sovereign.

The above By-laws were passed in open Conclave on 27th March, 1974.
