ORDER OF PROCEDURE.

- 1. The Deputy Provincial Grand Master enters the Lodge in processional order and takes the Chair.

- 3. The Deputy Provincial Grand Master will appoint Provincial Officers to occupy the Wardens Chairs.
- 4. Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies proceeds to left of S.V. and addresses the Chair thus "W.Bro. Deputy Provincial Grand Master, by the kindress will generosity of the Lolge has become possessed of a Banner which the Brethren desire you as behalf of the Province to accept and dedicties."
- 5. Deputy Provincial Grand Master. "W.B. .. Province al Grand D.C. has the design of this Banner been submitted to and approved by the M.W. rand Master or his advisers".
- 6. Provincial Grand D.C.

- 7. Deputy Provinci 1 Gr and Mas'el "I must now enquire what are the wishes of the W.Master and Brethren. Q' the Lodg in regard to this matter."
- 8. W.Bro. E. 11s. "W.Bro. Deputy Provincial Grand Master, I beg to propose that the Banner provided by Ind is hereby adopted as the Banner of the Keystone Lodge No. 6173.

Masonic Art, they may the better be enabled to unfold the beauties of true godliness, to the honour and glory of Thy Holy Name.

- 15. The Tyler reports "W.Bro. Provincial Grand Director of Cereporter and escort bearing the Banner of the Longer."

- 20. Deputy Provincial Grand Master. "In the name of the Provincial Grand Lodge of Warwickshire and on belial" of the Frethran of the Lodge I accept this Banner and declare that it is now adopted as the Banner of the Keystene Lodge, No. 6173 in the Register of the Grand Lodge of lagland.
- 21. De put g Provincial Grand Master. adds any special remarks he considers appropriate to this particular occasion.
- Deputy Provincial Grand Master. I now call upon the Provincial Grand Chaplain for the dedication Prayer.
- 23. Provincial Grand Chaplain O Lord our Heavenly Father, Architect and Ruler of the Universe, Who dost from thy throne behold all the dwellers on earth, we beseech Thee to bless and hallow this Banner which we here consecrate as a symbol of our Masonic Fellowship, and to the honour and glory of Thy Most Holy Name. Grant to all who gather beneath its shadow, wisdom to teach, humility to learn and grace to fulfil their obligations. Pour down upon them and upon all the members of our Fraternity the continual dew of Thy blessing, that we may daily increase in love of Thee and of one another; and when earth's fitful day is passed, grant unto us a happy death and a glorious

entry into Thy Heavenly Temple where, amid the company of Thy faithful people, we may shine like the stars for ever and ever.
