The Provincial Grand Lodge will be opened.

The Minutes of the last Annual Provincial Grand Lodge will be read and put for confirmation.

The Roll of Lodges will be called.

Letters and Communications will be read by the Provincial Grand Sec.

The M.W. Pro Grand Master, together with the Grand Officers, will enter the Hall in Procession.

The M.W. Pro Grand Master will be Sauted according to Ancient form.

The M.W. Pro Grand Master will Precess the Provincial Grand Lodge and state the object of the Meeting.

The Arrival of the R.W. Provincial Grand Master of Monmouthshire (designate), Bro. Frederick Phillips, will be announced.

The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will be requested to send in his Patent.

The Grand Director of Ceremonies will then retire and bring in the Patent and present it to the Installing Master.

The M.W. Pro Grand Master, having examined the Patent, will direct a Deputation of Seven Masters or Past Masters to retire with the Grand Director of Ceremonies, and Introduce the R.W. Provincial Grand Master (designate) and place him before the Pedestal.

*(The Brethren stand to order as M.Ms. on his entrance).*

The Grand Secretary will be directed to read the Patent.

Prayer by the Senior Provincial Grand Chaplain.

The M.W. Pro Grand Master will **Address** the R.W. Provincial Grand Master (designate), and enquire if he can conscientiously undertake the duties of the Office.

The R.W. Provincial Grand Master (designate), will then kneel and take the O.B. He will then be **Invested** with the Apron, Chain, and Jewel of Office, and placed in the Chair.

The M.W. Pro Grand Master will then be **Conducted to the Chair** on the right of the R.W. Provincial Grand Master.

The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will then be **Proclaimed and Saluted**.

The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will then **Appoint his Deputy** (whose Patent is then read) who will be conducted between two Deacons to the front of the Pedestal.

He is **Addressed** by the R.W. Provincial Grand Master on the Duties of his Office, then Obligated, Invested, and placed in the Chair.

The Deputy Provincial Grand Master will then be **Proclaimed and Saluted**.

The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will then **Appoint and Invest** certain other Provincial Grand Officers.

**Resolutions and Votes of Thanks** to be proposed, and any other business deemed necessary to give effect to the special object of the Meeting.

Provincial Grand Lodge will then be **Closed**.
