## Order of Proceedings.

---

The Brethren assemble in the Lodge Room and the Consecrating Officer takes the chair and opens the Lodge in the Three Degrees.

The Consecrating Officer addresses the Brethren on the object of the meeting, first calling on the Chaplain for the benefit of Prayer.

The Acting Secretary addresses the Consecrating Officer.

The Consecrating Officer replies and gives directions.

The Petitioners for the New Lodge are arranged in order.

The Acting Secretary reads the Petition and the Warrant.

The Consecrating Officer enquires of the Brethren of the Lodge if they approve of the Officers named in the Warrant.

The Petitioners signify their approval in Masonic Form and resume their seats.

### An Oration

(by the Chaplain) on the Nature and Principles of the Institution.

### Dedication Prayer. (*First Portion.*)

Response (*Omnes*)—"Glory be to Thee, O God."

The Brethren turn to the East and the Consecrating Officer gives

### The Invocation.

Chant (*Omnes*)—"So mote it be."

The Brethren resume their seats.

The Chaplain reads II. Chronicles, Chap ii, verses 1 to 16.

The Lodge Board is uncovered and the Petitioners arranged in order.

The Consecrating Officer and Wardens perambulate the Lodge bearing Corn, Wine and Oil.

Before the first circuit the Chaplain reads Psalm lxxii, verse 16.

The Consecrating Officer scatters CORN—the Emblem of PLENTY and ABUNDANCE.

Response—"Glory be to God on High."

Before the second circuit the Chaplain reads Nehemiah x, verse 39.

The Consecrating Officer sprinkles WINE—the Emblem of Joy and GLADNESS.

Response—"Glory be to God on High."

Before the third circuit the Chaplain reads Exodus xxx, verses 25 and 26.

The Consecrating Officer sprinkles OIL—the Emblem of PEACE and HARMONY.

Response—"Glory be to God on High."

Before the fourth circuit the Chaplain reads Leviticus ii, verse 13.

The Consecrating Officer strews SALT—the Emblem of FIDELITY, HOSPITALITY and EVERLASTING FRIENDSHIP.

Response—"Glory be to God on High."

**The Consecrating Officer Dedicates the Lodge.**

**Anthem (Omnes).**

O how amiable are Thy dwellings, Thou Lord of Hosts. My soul hath a desire and longing to enter the Courts of the Lord. My heart and my flesh rejoice in the living God.

Blessed are they that dwell in Thy house; they shall always be praising Thee.

Hallelujah!

The Chaplain carries the Censer three times round the Lodge.

First Circuit (reads)—And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning.

Second Circuit—When he dresseth the lamps, he shall burn incense on it.

Third Circuit—And when Aaron lighteth the lamps at even he shall burn it: a perpetual incense before the Lord throughout your generations.
