## BYE-LAWS

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1. The Library and Museum shall be under the control of a Committee, consisting of the General Purpose Committee of the Province (P.G.L. By-Law No. VI), with the addition of one representative from each Lodge or Subscribing Masonic Body in the Province, who shall meet at least once in each year. They shall appoint a Management Sub-Committee, with full powers to act as may be deemed necessary.

2. The Library shall be opened (except during the month of July) on Tuesday and Thursdays, between the hours of 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. ; on Saturdays from 2 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. ; and may be inspected at other times by applying to the Custodian.

3. A Custodian shall be appointed, whose remuneration shall be fixed by the Management Committee.

4. No Book or Article may be removed from the premises without the sanction

of the Management Committee, through the Secretary, who shall keep a book recording all such loans.

5. Collections may be loaned for exhibition purposes to any Masonic body at the discretion of the Management Committee.

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The Committee will be pleased to receive gifts or loans of Books, Manuscripts, Medals, Jewels, or Clothing of Masonic interest.

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### IMPORTANT

The Committee is prepared to undertake the custody of old Masonic Books, Memoranda, Documents, &c., for which a fireproof safe has been provided.
