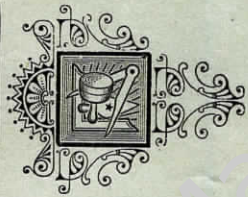
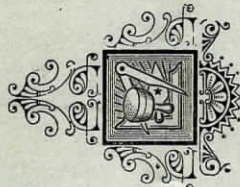

BUSINESS.

- 1.—To read and put for confirmation the Minutes of last Meeting.

- 3.—To pass, or raise those eligible.
