1. To open the Chapter at 5-0 p.m. precisely.
2. To read, and if approved, confirm the minutes of the sixth Convocation, held 23rd day, of October, 1883.
3. To PERFECT if present (having been already elected)—R.W. Bro. the Rt. Hon. the Earl Ferrers, Prov. G.M., and Bro. Captain T. R. Pickering, M.M., John of Gaunt Lodge, No. 523.
(Pursuant to By-Law IV., the Election of these Brethren may become void if they are not Perfected at this Meeting.)
4. To elect by ballot the M.W.S. for the ensuing year.
5. To elect in the same manner a Treasurer for the like period.
6. To elect by a show of hands the Outer Guards of the Chapter for the year ensuing.
7. To read the Annual Circular of the Supreme Council 33°.
8. Ill. Bro. T. Worthington, First G, to move, pursuant to notice, that the word "shall" be inserted for "may," in the last line but one of By-Law IV.
9. To read the Chapter By-Laws, should time permit.
10. Supreme Council Certificates await Ex : and P. Bros. I. Wright and S. Wand.
11. The Treasurer to receive Subscriptions, due March 27, 1883.
12. To receive regularly made nominations of Candidates for Perfection.
13. To transact any further business that may be regularly brought before the Chapter.
14. To collect Alms, and close the Chapter according to ancient usage.

N.B.—Candidates for Perfection (who must have been Master Masons for at least one year) should be provided with their Grand Lodge Certificate, and appear in Craft (or Royal Arch) Clothing, and duly provided with the Apron, Sword, Colla and Jewel of the Rose Croix (18th) degree.
