REGULATIONS

TO BE OBSERVED AT THE

PROVINCIAL GRAND LODGE

TO BE HOLDEN AT THE

Mechanics' Institute, Vernon Place, Scarborough,

*On Thursday, 10th September, 1885.*

*Previous to the Meeting the Brethren and Visitors will be fraternally welcome at the Masonic Hall (opposite the Grand Hotel,) where light refreshments will be provided.*

---

THE BOARD OF BENEVOLENCE will meet at the Masonic Hall, at 1 p.m. Members attending the Board will appear in full Masonic Clothing.

The Provincial Grand Lodge will be held at the Mechanics' Institute, Vernon Place, and will be opened at 2 p.m. precisely.

1. Reception and Robing Rooms for all the Brethren and Visitors will be provided at the Mechanics' Institute, where they will clothe, and sign their names.

They will then, on being vouched for, or recognized or proved by the Stewards in attendance, receive vouchers for admission to the Lodge Room, and there take their seats as directed by the Stewards.

3. The Provincial Grand Officers present and past, and the Prov. Grand Officers of other Provinces, will proceed in procession ( Juniors first ) from their Robing Room to the Lodge Room. Special seats will be provided for all the Present Provincial Grand Officers ; the Past Prov. Grand Officers, will be seated on the Dais.
4. On the announcement of the approach of the Prov. Grand Master and the Prov. Grand Lodge, the Brethren will rise, and remain standing until Prov. Grand Lodge is opened when they will greet the Right Worshipful Prov. Grand Master with Grand Honours seven times, and the W. Deputy Prov. Grand Master five times, taking time from the Prov. Grand Director of Ceremonies.
5. In Prov. Grand Lodge no one is entitled to speak, unless with the special permission of the Presiding Officer, or to vote on any question, except the Members thereof, (viz. : Present and Past Prov. Grand Officers, Masters, Past Masters, and *Present* Wardens of Private Lodges within the Province).

On any vote being taken they will rise and give their votes standing.

6. When the Provincial Grand Lodge is closed, the Brethren will remain standing while the Prov. Grand Master and the Prov. Grand Lodge retire in procession (Seniors first). The Brethren may then retire.
7. The Banquet will be held at the Royal Hotel, at 4 p.m. On arriving at the Banqueting Room, the Brethren will at once take their seats and await the arrival of the Provincial Grand Master and his Officers, who will enter in procession.
8. The Brethren will appear in full Masonic Craft Clothing in accordance with the Constitutions of Grand Lodge. (Craft and Royal Arch Jewels only permitted). At the Banquet Collars and Jewels only to be worn.
