The Brethren assemble in the Ante-room, and walk in procession to the Lodge Room.

The Presiding Officer takes the Chair, appoints Officers (*pro. tem.*) and opens Lodge.

The Presiding Officer addresses the Brethren as to the object of the meeting.

The Founders of the New Lodge are arranged in order.

The Petition and Warrant are read.

The Presiding Officer enquires of the Brethren of the New Lodge if they approve of the Officers named in the Warrant.

The Brethren signify their approval.

The Presiding Officer then proceeds to CONSTITUTE the Lodge.

INVOCATION.

An ORATION will then be delivered on the principles of Mark Masonry.

The Presiding Officer and three other Officers form a Procession.

The Lodge Board is uncovered.

Consecration Prayer, I.

Brethren—"No mote it be."

Sanctus—"Glory be to Thee, O Lord."

The Procession now makes the circuit of the Lodge, bearing Corn, Wine, Oil, and Salt.

During First Circuit, Brethren Sing:—

When once of Old in Israel,
Our early Brethren wrought with toil,
Jehovah's blessing on them fell,
In showers of Corn, and Wine, and Oil.

Corn is scattered.

Grand Honours.

During Second Circuit, Brethren Sing:—

When there a Shrine to Him alone
They built, with worship, sin to foil;
On threshold and on corner-stone,
They poured out Corn, and Wine, and Oil.

Wine is poured out.

During Third Circuit, Brethren Sing :—

And we have come, fraternal bands,
With joy, and pride, and prosperous spoil,
To honour Him, by voice and hands,
With streams of Corn, and Wine, and Oil.

Oil is poured out.

During Fourth Circuit, Brethren Sing :—

To build on the great corner-stone
To Him who oversees our toil,
This Temple to His praise alone,
Who gave us Salt, Corn, Wine, and Oil.

Salt is strewed.
