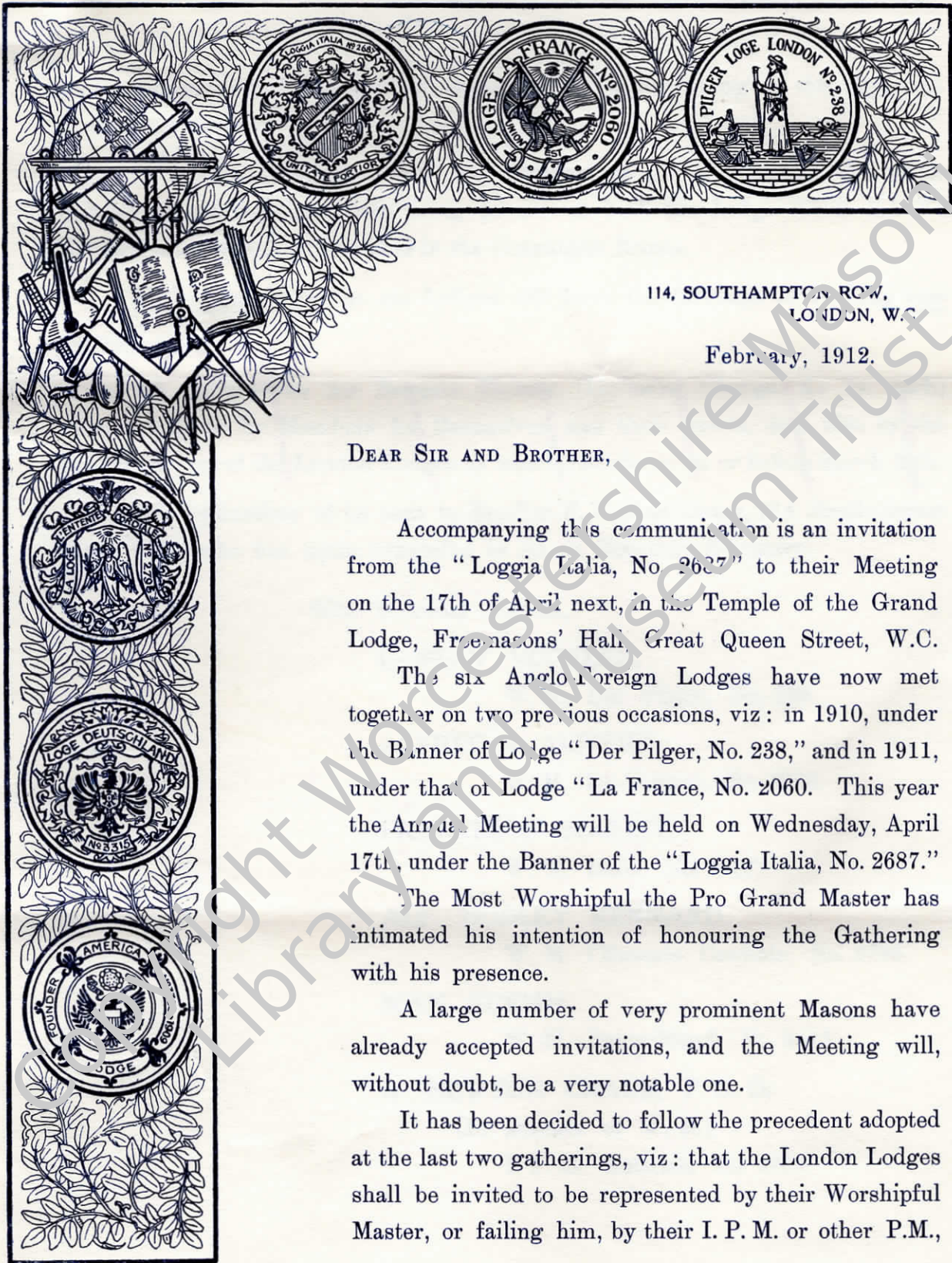

DEAR SIR AND BROTHER,

Accompanying this communication is an invitation from the "Loggia Italia, No 2687" to their Meeting on the 17th of April next, in the Temple of the Grand Lodge, Freemasons' Hall, Great Queen Street, W.C.

The six Anglo-Foreign Lodges have now met together on two previous occasions, viz: in 1910, under the Banner of Lodge "Der Pilger, No. 238," and in 1911, under that of Lodge "La France, No. 2060. This year the Annual Meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 17th, under the Banner of the "Loggia Italia, No. 2687."

The Most Worshipful the Pro Grand Master has intimated his intention of honouring the Gathering with his presence.
