- To elect an Equerry for the ensuing year.
- To appoint a place for holding the next Annual Meeting of Grand Priory.
- To transact any other business for the good of the Order and the benefit of the Province.
- The Grand Commander will appoint and invest his Officers for the ensuing year.
- To collect the Alms.
- To close Grand Priory.
