As I noticed from the report of  
your collection that it includes  
impressions in wax of old Lodge  
Seals I send half a dozen for  
your acceptance.

No 1. Is the seal of an Atholl Lodge  
long since extinct. Constituted under  
the no 166 in 1787 & altered to 203 at  
the Union.

No 2. Is the original seal of the  
present Perseverance Lodge 213. Constituted  
as no 294 in 1795. this is also an  
Atholl Lodge.

No 3. Also a seal of the Perseverance

Lodge 213. formerly known as the  
City of Norwich Union Lodge & no.  
374 from the Union to 1832.

No 4. Seal of the same Lodge for  
the Ark masons degree. The number  
has been altered in the seal from  
294 to 374 and from 374 to 258.  
the seal was engraved & is dated 1802.

No 5. Seal of the same Lodge for  
the K T degree.

No 6. Seal of the Royal Arch Chapter  
attached to the Perseverance Lodge.  
the no on the seal has been altered  
from 294 to 374.

All these seals are now in private  
possession but I have been able  
to borrow them to have some  
impressions taken. It is a great
