LESSON. 1 Chronicles, Chaple 28.

ND David assembled all the princes of srael, the princes of the tribes, and the captains of the companies that ministered to the king by course, and the captains over the thousands, and captains over the hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possession of the king, and of his sons, with the officers, and with the mighty men, and with all the valiant men, unto Jerusalem

Then David the king tood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me. my brethren, and my people. As for me, I had in mine heart to build an house of rest for the use of the covenant of the Lora, and for the footstool of our God and had made ready for the building.

3. But God said to me, Tou shalt not build an house for my

name, because the a hast been a n an of war, and hast shed blood.

4. Howbeit the Lord God of Israel chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Israel for ever: for he hath chosen Judah to be the ruler and of the louse of Judah, the house of my father; and among its ons of my father he liked me to make me king over all Israel:

And of all my sons (for the Lord hath given me many sons,) he both hosen Solomon my son to sit upon the throne of the kingdom

of the Lord over Israel.

And he said unto me, Solomon thy son, he shall build my house and my courts: for I have chosen him to be my son, and I will be his ather.

Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant

to do my commandments and my judgments, as at this day.

8. Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the LORD, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the commandments of the Lord your God: that ye may possess this good land, and leave it for an inheritance for your children after you for ever.

- 9. ¶ And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.
- 10. Take heed now; for the LORD hath chosen thee to build an house for the sanctuary: be strong and do it.

Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch. and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat.

And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries

of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things:

13. Also for the courses of the priests and the Levites, and for all the work of the service of the house of the LORD, and for all the vessels of service in the house of the LORD.

14. He gave of gold by weight for things of gold, for all instruments of all manner of service; silver also for all instruments of silver by weight

for all instruments of every kind of service :

15. Even the weight for the candlesticks of gold, and for their an ps of gold, by weight for every candlestick, and for lamps thereof: and for the candlesticks of silver by weight, both for the candlestick, and also for the lamps thereof, according to the use of every candlestick.

16. And by weight he gave gold for the tables of she vbread, for

every table; and likewise silver for the tables of silver:

17. Also pure gold for the fleshhooks, and the bowls, and the cups: and for the golden basons he gave gold by weight for every baron; and likewise silver by weight for every bason of silve.

18. And for the altar of incense refined gold by weight; and gold for the pattern of the chariot of the cherub ms, that spread out their

wings, and covered the ark of the covenant of the LORL

19. All this, said David, the LORD made me understand in writing

by his hand upon me, even all the worrs of this pattern.

20. And David said to Solomon his son, Be s rong and of good courage, and do it: fear not, nor be dismayed for the Load God, even my God, will be with thee; he will not fair thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

21. And, behold, the courses of the priests and the Levites, even they shall be with thee for all the service of the nouse of God: and there shall be with thee for all manner of work, anship every willing skilful man, for any manner of service. also the princes and all the people will be wholly at thy commandment
