 The Celestial Cup that never was made by the hands of Man.  
 The wonderful Prophet the Cock.  
 The Lamb bearing a Flag by the Cross.  
 A Chandelier with five Lights.  
 The Scull and Marrow-bones, with the Sword.  
 The Armour of Salvation.  
 Mary Kneeling at the Cross.  
 St. John of Jerusalem with the Cup of Salvation.  
 The Ladder at the Cross with eight steps.  
 The Saw and Sponge.  
 The book of Wisdom with Cross Swords.  
 The pot of incense.  
 Aaron's Rod budding.  
 (Sit. Lux. et. Lux. Fuit). Let there be light and there was light.  
 A hand with tassels or scarlet lines.  
 Twenty-four Lights in a triangular form.  
 The Golden Eagle.  
 The Pelican spilling her blood to feed her young.  
 The three broken Pillars: Wisdom, Strength, and Beauty.  
 Urim and Thummim on the High Priest's Mitre, signifies perfect light.  
 A Plum-rule.
