Know Ye, that by virtue of the Patent, to me granted, by The Most Worshipful Grand Mark Master
Mason, and conformably to the Laws, and Constitutions, of the Grand Mark Lodge, in that behalf made, and also of the great trust,
and confidence, reposed in the right trusty, and well beloved Brother George Taylor of Kidderminster, Manufacturer, I do
hereby constitute, appoint and depute him the said George Taylor, My Deputy Provincial Grand Mark
Master Mason, and do fully authorize and empower him in my absence, for me, and in my name, to preside over the Mark Degree
in the Province of Worcestershire, and to regulate the Lodges therein, and also to convene Provincial Grand Lodges, for the same, in conformity with
the laws of the Grand Mark Lodge, at such times, and places, as to him may seem expedient, and necessary, and then and there to appoint Provincial
Grand Wardens, and other Officers, for the Provincial Grand Lodge; and generally to do, and perform, all such Acts, in my absence, as I might lawfully do,
if present, subject nevertheless, to such directions, and instructions, as I may at any time give touching the said Lodges, Masters, or Members belonging to them,
or otherwise, and I do hereby strictly enjoin my said Deputy, to take care that all, and every, the Lodges in the Province, and the Brethern thereof
respectively do conform to, and observe the laws, and regulations for the government of the order of Mark Master Masons.
