

The Viceroy and Governor-General of India in Council.

To Charles Arthur Owen, F. R. C. S. (Edin.) Gentleman, GREETING.

I, reposing special trust and confidence in your loyalty, ability, and good conduct, do by these Presents constitute, nominate, and appoint you *Charles Arthur Owen*, to be an officer in the Volunteer Forces of India from the first day of *October* one thousand nine hundred and *six*.

You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your duty as such in the rank of Surgeon *Lieutenant* or in such higher rank as you may from time to time hereafter be promoted or appointed to, of which a notification will be made in the *Gazette of India*, by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging. And you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from me or any other your superior officer, according to the rules and discipline of War, in pursuance of the Trust hereby reposed in you.
