BY-LAWS

The Regular Meetings of the Chapter shall be held on the third Thursday in January and April and the first Thursday in November at the Masonic Hall, Wellington Road, Dudley. Emergency Meetings may be held at the discretion of the M.W.S. of which Meetings at least seven days notice must be sent to all members of the Chapter.

II.

The M.W.S. and Treasurer shall be elected by ballot and the Outer Guard by show of hands, at the Meeting in January, and the M.W.S. Installed and the Officers invested in April in each year.

The following Fees shall be payable:

For Perfection, inclusive of Certificate, £10.

For Joining £5.

For Re-joining £1.

The Annual Subscription shall be £5.
Payable in advance in April.

IV.

Candidates for Perfection must be proposed and seconded in writing, stating their full name, profession or occupation, place of abode, the name and number of their Craft Lodge, and the date of their raising. The election shall be by ballot, which must be unanimous (one black ball to exclude).

V.

Any member whose subscription is unpaid for two years shall be liable to exclusion after written application for payment has been made.

VI.

The Treasurer's Accounts shall be audited by two Members elected in January, and presented by him at the Meeting in April in each year.

VII.

Brethren of distinction, or who may have rendered special service to the Order, may be elected Honorary Members at any ordinary Meeting of the Chapter.
