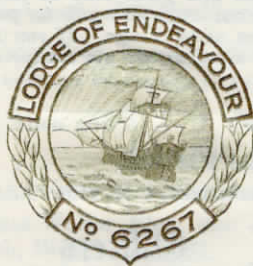

Antient Charge
