Blaise, or Blasius, was Bishop of Sebaste, in Asia Minor, and was martyred in 316 A.D. Legend has it that he was torn with woolcombers' irons before execution and this is possibly the reason for his becoming the Patron Saint of woolcombers. He was said to have possessed marvellous powers of healing.

The Chapel of St. Blaise was one of the early places of worship in Sutton Coldfield, and was situated in the precincts of Manor House, on Manor Hill. It continued until the 16th century.

It was to the Chapel of St. Blaise that John Harman (later Bishop Vesey) received his first preferment.
