The Lodge opened in the Second and Third Degrees.  
The M.W. Grand Master saluted.  
The M.W. Grand Master having ascertained from the Acting Grand Secretary that the proceedings for the erection of the new Lodge are all in order, the Petitioning Members will be marshalled, the Wor. Master and Wardens taking up their positions in the West, and the Officers and Brethren in the North and South.  
The Acting Grand Secretary, Wor. Bro. L. Freedman, will read the Petition and Charter.  
Psalm 133 will then be read by Rev. Bro. Acting Grand Chaplain.  
Hymn (Duffield). "Stand forth, O worthy craftsmen."  
During the singing of the hymn, the Grand Lodge Officers who are to present the Elements of Consecration will take their places round the Lodge Symbol.  
Solemn Music.  
The Lodge Symbol uncovered, Grand Officer's kneeling.  
Prayer by the Acting Grand Chaplain.  
The Acting Grand Chaplain sprinkles perfume.  
Chaplain: "May our deeds be sweet and savoury, may we be a refreshing odour to all our Poor Brethren, for Charity is as sweet as Roses."  
The Consecration Elements.  
The Grand Officers, in procession, make the circuit of the Lodge, bearing Corn, Wine, Oil and Salt.
