ATTENTION IS CALLED TO BY-LAW, No. 14:—

"The Subscription to be Three Pounds per annum, payable half-yearly in advance, in the months of January and July; any Member in arrears twelve months is liable to be excluded the Lodge."

EXTRACTS FROM THE BOOK OF CONSTITUTIONS.

"No Lodge shall pay the Quarterly Contributions (to Grand Lodge) for a Member who is in arrear, but his name shall be returned with the words 'in arrear' written against it. Should a Member be excluded, or withdraw himself from a Lodge without having paid up, he is not eligible to join another Lodge without that Lodge making due enquiry, failing which such Lodge is liable to pay all arrears due to the Lodge he formerly belonged to."
