#### "STABILITY" BACKGROUND

In 1813 two English Grand Lodges amalgamated to form the present United Grand Lodge. On amalgamation each Grand Master appointed nine "worthies" plus two secretarys (total twenty) to form the Lodge of Reconciliation, which was entrusted with the duty of establishing and securing the "most perfect unity of obligation, of discipline, of working the lodges, of making, passing and raising, instructing and clothing Brother." During 1814-15 eight brethren, including Philip Broadfoot, were appointed to fill vacancies. The system as settled and taught by the Lodge of Reconciliation was approved by United G and Lodge at the Quarterly Communication on 5th June, 1816. Its work completed, the Lodge of Reconciliation was dissolved, but ten of its monvers, realising the need of an authoritative teaching body, joined the Stability Lodge of Instruction (three of the te. including Philip Broadfoot, being Founder members). "There may have been other general Lodges of Instruction working at that time, but it so they have left no record and have no present axistence."

It is of interest onto that the Emulation Lodge of Improvement came into being in 1823, and its figure-head, Peter Gilkes, joined in 1825. Unlike "Stability," which from its earliest date in 1817 concentrated on the site al and ceremonial as approved by Grand Lodge in 1816, Bro. Gilke's stated in 1830 that in the Emulation L. of I be taught "ca'y Lectures."
