 accordingly.

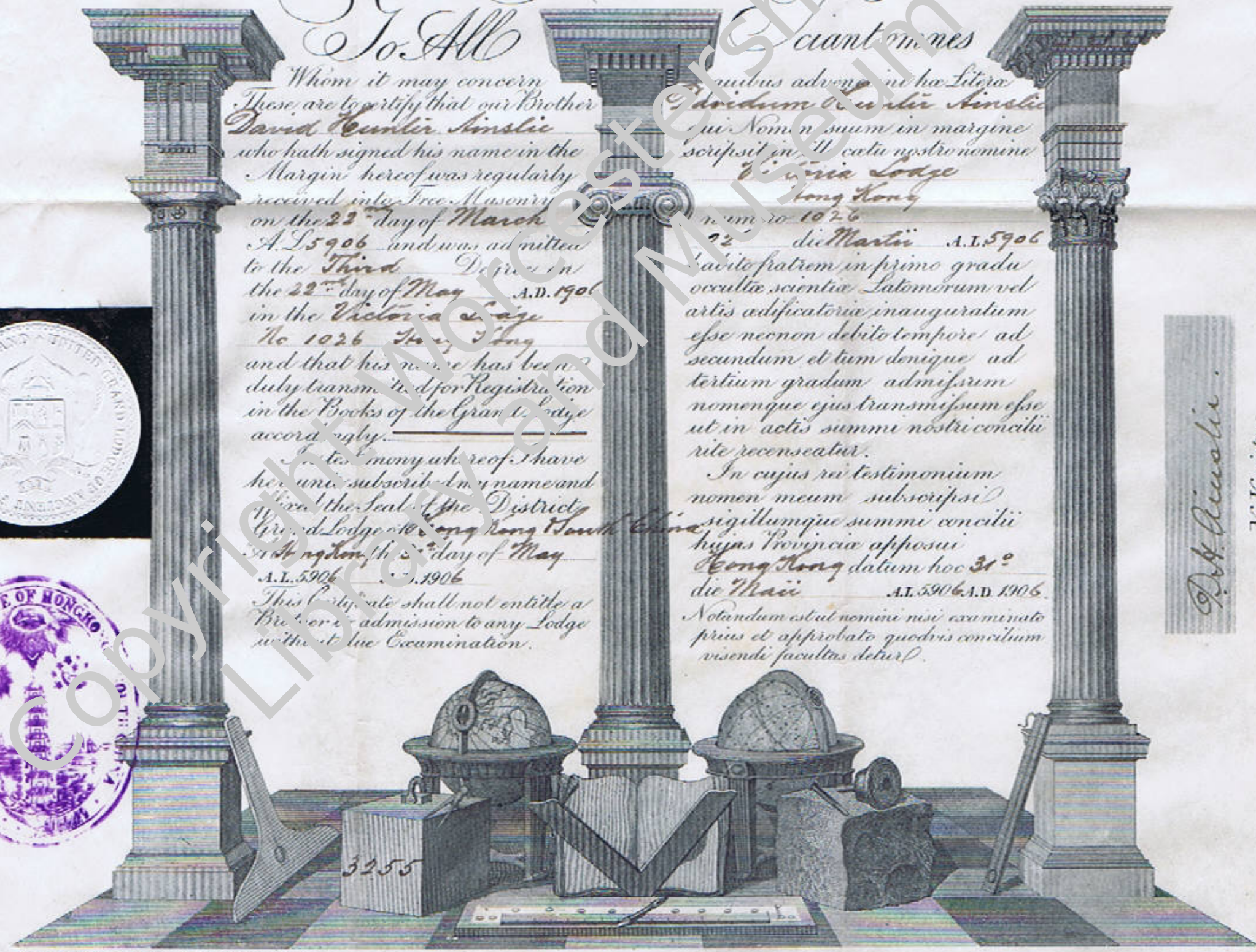
