- KALICK! GT. MARSHAL: Very High and Eminent Great Seneschal, the Most Eminent and Supreme Knight, the Earl of He ewood, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Carter, Knight Grand Cross, who has been elected Grand praster of the United Orders of the Temple and Hospital is without and demands admittance in order that he may be installed
- GT. SENESCHAL: Very Eminent Great Mershal you will form the appropriate Escort to introduce the Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master in due form.
- GT. MARSHAL: Will the following Very Eminent Knights please

The Escort recires:-

GRAND MASTER'S BANNER BEARER.

Gt. Seneschal: Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master, you have been unanimously elected to preside over the United Religious and Military Orders of the Temple and of St. John of Jerusalem, Palestine, Rhodes and Malta in England and Wales and the Dominions and Dependencies of the British Crown, and I now therefore enquire if you are willing to take the Obligation of that high Office?

GRAND MASTER: I am.

- GT. Seneschal: Then I request you to join us ir sup licating the blessing and assistance of the Divine Power.
- GT. PRELATE: Advances to the front of the Altar, and faces base. Almighty God, Who rulest the hearts of the greatest and humblest upon earth, we beseech Thee to imbust his Thy servant with Thy Divine Grace that he may rule aright all those committed to his charge and, ever relying upon Thy protecting care, he may godfy Thee in all his works. Endow us with Thy Wisdom that we may render due obedience to him who, under Thy guiding hover, has been set in authority over us. This we preve through Christ our Prophet, Christ our Proest, and Court our King.—A-MEN.
- Gt. Seneschal: Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master, I now request you to kneel on both knees, place your right hand upon the Holy Gospels, and recite the Obligation of your Office.

Obligation of the Grand Master.

1, in the Name of the Holy and Undivided Trinity, and in the presence of this Great Priory, duly constituted and convened, do hereby and hereon promise and now that I will undertake the government of the United Pengious and Military Orders of the Temple and of St. John of Jerusalem, Palestine, Rhodes and Malta in England and Wales and the Dominions and Dependencies of the British Crown; observing all such things as shall promote the well-being and dignity thereof, and protecting and upholding the same to the best of my ability.

I will maintain the King's Supremacy.

I will judge the rich as the poor and the poor as the rich, without distinction of rank, without bias favour or affection,

and will act uprightly fearlessly and impartially between man and man.

And hereunto I pledge my Knightly Oath, so help me Christ Emanuel.

- Gt. Seneschal: You will seal that Obligation on the Holy Gospels nine times with your lips.
- Gt. Prelate: advances to West of The Sepulchre and, taking the Grand Master by the right hand, says:—

Arise, be steadfast with the help of Christ.

The Great Constables resume their stations.

- GT. MARSHAL: Brother Knights, Be-seated.
- GT. PRELATE: conducts the Grand Master to the foot of the Throne, and resumes his seat.

The Escort: follows to the East.

Investiture and Installation.

GT. SENECHAL:

I invest you with the Steel Chain of the Order and the Cross of Salem.

Receive the Mantle of the Order, bearing the Insignia of your Office.

When the Mantle is put on, the Great Seneschal replaces the Chain of a Knight Grand Cross.

Receive the Sword; the mblem of Imperium, or Military Power. Tenner Justice with Mercy.

Receive the Beton the emblem of Potestas, or Civil Authority. Be just and fear not.

Leceive the Rue bearing the triple Cross of Salem; emblem or your perpetual Union with the Order.

Finally I deliver to you the Book of Statutes: the emblem of Law and Right.

- Gt. Marshal: Brother Knights, To-Order.
- Gt. Seneschal: I place you upon the Throne as Grand Master of the United Orders in England and Wales and the Dominions and Dependencies of the British Crown.

Gt. Prelate: advances to the Throne and pronounces the Benediction:—

Pax et Benedictio Dei Omnipotentis, Patris, Filii, et Spiritus Sancti, in te descendat et tecum maneat in saecula saeculorum. Amen.

THE ESCORT: resumes stations.

GT. SENESCHAL: Very Eminent Great Marshal, you will cause the Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Mas er to be 1.voclaimed in due form.

Gt. Marshal: conducts the Great Herald to the West.

GT. MARSHAL: Brother Knights, with NINE.

Gt. Marshal: Brother Knights, Be-sected. conducts the Great Herald to his station.

THE GRAND MASTER ADDRESSES GREAT PRIDLY.

THE GRAND MASTER announces the name of the Knight whom he appoints to be Very High and Liminent Great Seneschal.

Gt. Marshal: conducts the Very High and Eminent Great Seneschal to the West of the Sepulchre.

THE GRAND M STER: I aving appointed you to the high and disting visited Office of Seneschal, before I install you I must ask if you are able and willing to accept the duties and reconsibilities of that High Office.

Granis I am.

THE GRAND MASTER: Then you will join us in supplicating the assistance of the Divine Power.

Gt. Prelate: advances to the front of the Altar, and faces East.

GT. MARSHAL: Brother Knights, To-Order

Gt. Prelate: Almighty and Most Merciful God, Who guidest the actions of men, we beseech Thee to imbue this Thy servant with Wisdom and Understanding, so that, when called upon, he may render a just account to his earthly Superior, and stand justified before God and man in all his works.

This we pray, through Christ our Prophet, Christ our Prost, and Christ our King.—A-MEN.

THE GRAND MASTER: You will kneel on both knees, via ce your right hand upon the Holy Gospels, and recite the obligation of your Office.

The Great Constables advance, and cross their words above the head of the Great Senesche.

Obligation of the Great Seneschal.

I,, in the lame of the Holy and Undivided Trinity, and in the presence of this Great Priory, solemnly promise and vow that will, to the lest of my ability, discharge the duties of Beneschal of England and Wales and the Dominions and Dependen has of the British Crown under the Grand Maste.

I will uphold the honor and dignity of the Order and of this mine office.

I will not imringe, or suffer to be infringed, the Statutes, Laws, or negulations of the Order.

1 will do suit and service in the Court of my Feudal Superior when thereunth required.

I vill make all regular reports and will hele nothing from the knowledge of the Grand Master.

I will uphold the King's Supremacy.

I will judge the rich as the poor and the poor as the rich, without distinction of rank, without bias favour or affection, and will act uprightly fearlessly and impartially between man and man.

And hereunto I pledge my Knightly Oath, so help me Christ Emanuel.

THE GRAND MASTER: You will seal that Obligation on the Holy Gospels seven times with your lips.

Gt. Prelate: advances to West of S. and, taking the Great Seneschal by the right hand, says:—

Arise, be steadfast by the help of Christ.

The Great Constables resume their stations.

- Gt. Prelate: conducts the Great Seneschal to the foot of the Throne, and resumes his seat.
- Gt. Seneschal: Kneels and, placing both hands between 'noso of the Grand Master, pays Homage:—

In my own name, and on behalf of all Knights of the Religious and Military Order of the Temple in England na Wales and the Dominions and Dependencies of the British Crown, I promise to be your liege man and true, and I deposit my homage and fealty between your hands.

- THE GRAND MASTER: I accept the homes which you present in your own name, and on behalf of the Knights of the Order.
- THE GRAND MASTER: Raises the Great Senerchal and installs him.
- THE GRAND MASTER: Very Eminent Great Marshal, you will cause the Very H.g. and En inent Great Seneschal to be proclaimed in due form.
- Gt. Marshal: conducts the Great Herald to the West.
