JOHN SMITH, SECRETARY.

1.—That the Lodge be called the **GRAND MASTERS' LODGE OF INSTRUCTION** for Mark Master Masons.

2.—That the regular meetings of the Lodge be held at Mark Masons' Hall, Great Queen Street, London, on the first and third Fridays in the months of October, November, December, January, February and March in each year. The Lodge shall be opened at 6 o'clock punctually.

3.—That any Mark Mason may be proposed, seconded and elected to membership by show of hands at any meeting; that the entrance fee be 2/6 and the annual subscription 2/6; that each member pay 6d. per night when present in addition to such subscription; that a member may compound for life by a single payment of 21/-, in addition to the entrance fee, when he shall not be called upon for the nightly attendance fee; that members wishing to resign membership of the Lodge shall intimate their intention either in open Lodge or by letter to the Secretary.

4.—That Visitors may be introduced by any member to any of the meetings, but the same visitor may not be present on more than two consecutive occasions. The visitor's fee shall be 1/- per night, and the introducing member shall be responsible for the payment.

5.—That the Lodge may elect any Brother as an honorary member, in consideration of distinguished services rendered to the Lodge.

6.—That the Lodge be managed by a Committee, consisting of a Preceptor, Treasurer, Secretary and members, who shall be elected annually at the first meeting in October. No one shall be eligible for re-election unless he shall have attended four regular meetings during the preceding year, or be an officer of Grand Lodge.
