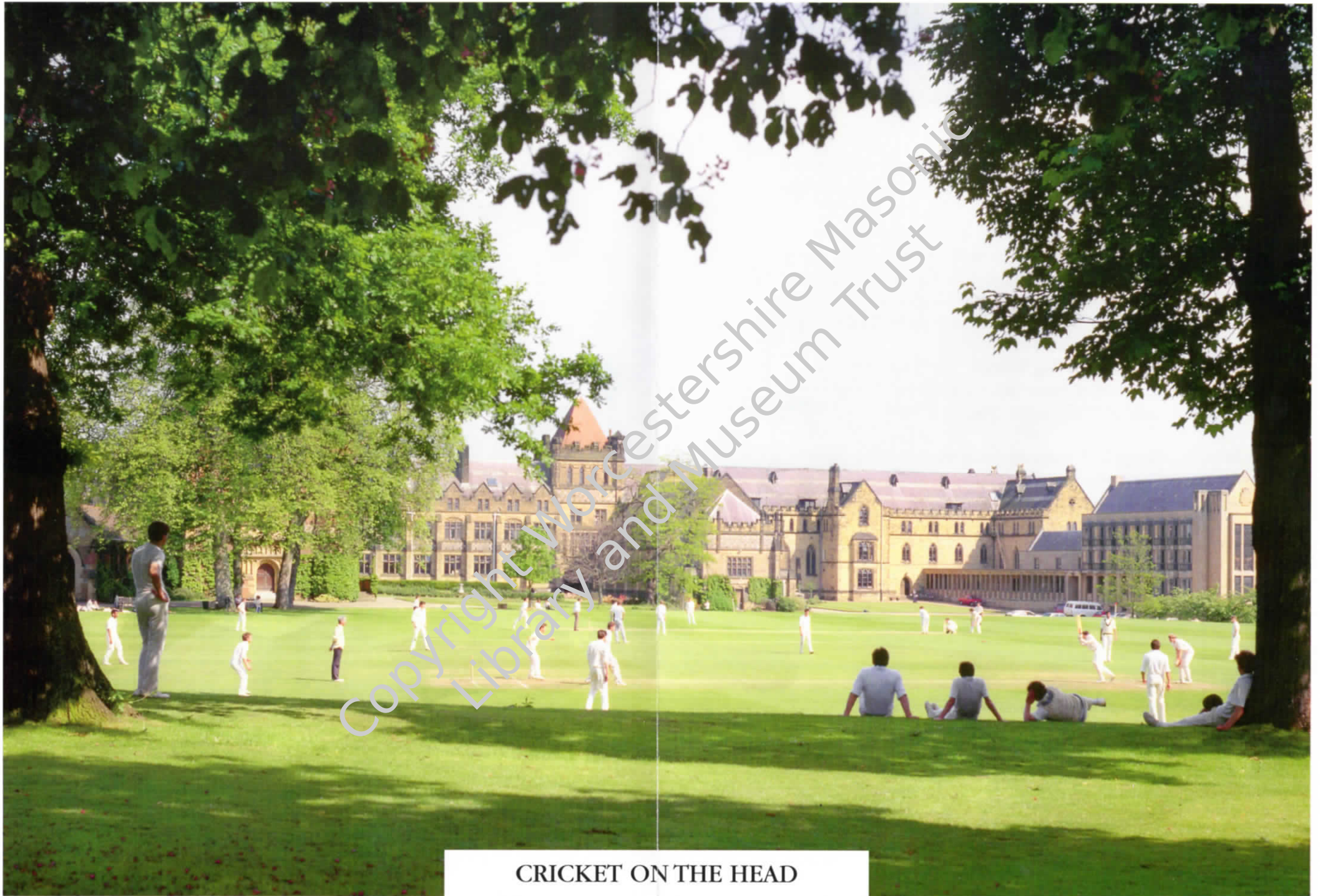

OUTLINE PROGRAMME

9.00 Onwards. Coffee in the Marquee on the Upper Hundred.

10.15 Service in the School Chapel. The largest ecclesiastical work for many years was the rebuilding of the Chapel that was almost completely destroyed by fire in 1988. This with its magnificent new organ by Marcussen & Son again dominates the School. The service will be held by the School Chaplain and the preacher will be The Rev'd Kennedy L McCready, Provincial Grand Chaplain, West Kent. It will include the school orchestra, full choir and brass for which the school is rightly highly regarded.

11.30 Lodge Meeting in Big School. An interesting and entertaining ceremony is promised, the main part being a short presentation entitled "Behind the Tracing Board".

11.30 in the Chapel. A separate entertainment programme will be held for ladies and non-Masonic guests. This will include a vocal Baroque ensemble, the Organ and Brass.

12.30 Champagne Reception in or adjacent to the Marquee

13.15 Lunch in the Marquee. An excellent festive board is promised, and will be followed by the usual toasts, speeches and a special presentation.

15.30 Tours. Following lunch there will be an opportunity for escorted tours of the school and to watch the second day of the First XI against Bedford on the Head.
