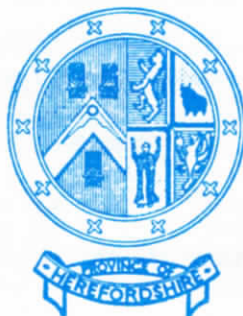

- 5.30 p.m.** Provincial Grand Lodge will be opened.

BUSINESS OF PROVINCIAL GRAND LODGE

1. To approve the Minutes of the Provincial Grand Lodge Meeting held on 3rd June, 1991, (see 1991 Year Book).
2. To announce apologies for absence.
3. Obituary.
4. To announce the attendance of Brethren of Lodges in the Province.
5. To receive reports from Lodges, in conformity with By-Law 15.
6. To receive the Provincial Grand Secretary's report (see 1992 Year Book).
7. To receive for adoption the Provincial Grand Treasurer's audited Accounts (see 1992 Year Book)
8. To elect a Provincial Grand Treasurer for the ensuing year. Nominations must be made by 9th May, 1992.
9. To receive the Charity Accounts (see 1992 Year Book).
10. The Provincial Grand Treasurer will propose Provincial Grand Lodge dues for the ensuing year in accordance with By-Law 10.
11. The Provincial Grand Treasurer will propose:
 - i. the Registration Fee for a Deputy Provincial Grand Master be increased from £5 to £25 and from £5 to £10 for all other officers of Provincial Grand Lodge and that By-Law No. 9 be amended accordingly.
 - ii. a. the maximum Fee payable for every subscribing member of each Lodge be increased from £3 to £10.
 - b. the Fee payable for every Initiate be increased from 50 pence to £5.
 - c. The Fee payable for every Brother, Joining or re-Joining a Lodge be increased from 15 pence to £2.50.
 - d. the Warrant Fee for a new Lodge be increased from £2.25 to £25.
 - e. that By-Law No. 10 be amended accordingly.
12. To announce the appointment of four Brethren to the Provincial Committee in conformity with By-Law
14. Those appointed are W.Bro. C. N. Lurkett, W.Bro. E. M. Staite, W.Bro. K. S. A. Morgan, W.Bro. F. N. Colquitt.
13. To appoint and invest the Provincial Grand Officers for the ensuing year.
14. The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master will address Provincial Grand Lodge.
15. To elect three Representatives to the Associated Masonic Provinces.
16. To authorise the Provincial Grand Master to support the nomination of Very Worshipful Bro. Jack Smallcombe, P.C.S.W., B. Deputy Provincial Grand Master of Bristol, for re-election to the Board of General Purposes in March, 1993.
17. To authorise the Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to nominate a qualified brother of this Province as Representative to fill any casual vacancy which may arise on the Committee of Management of the Masonic Institutions.
18. To vote sums to the Herefordshire Masonic Charity Association.
19. To elect Auditors.
20. To make a collection on behalf of one of the Charity Funds.
21. To name the Lodge under whose banner the next Annual Meeting of Provincial Grand Lodge will be held and announce the date.
22. To close the Provincial Grand Lodge.

PROVINCIAL CHURCH SERVICE

**Marking the 275th Anniversary of
The Grand Lodge of England**

A Provincial Church Service will be held in Hereford Cathedral, on Sunday, 21st June, 1992 at 3.30 p.m., to which all Brethren and their families are invited.

Brethren should assemble and robe in the Cloisters at 3.00 p.m., in the positions allocated and be ready to process into the Cathedral through the St. John's door at 3.15 p.m. Lodges will proceed to the Cathedral led by the Host Lodge, followed by other Lodges, led by the respective D.C.'s followed by the Master, Wardens, Past Masters and Brethren, and will occupy the seats allocated on the right side of the Nave. The Grand Officers, Present Provincial Grand Officers and the Past Provincial Grand Wardens will then process into the Cathedral.

All Brethren will retire in procession after the choir and clergy have retired.

A collection will be taken during the Service. It is hoped that a large number of Brethren and their families will attend. Families will occupy seats on the left of the Nave and should be seated by 3.00 p.m.

Dress: Dark morning dress will be worn with full Masonic clothing.
