ORDER OF PROCEDURE

- To Open the Lodge at 5.45 p.m.
- The R.W. Prov. Grand Master, accompanied by the Dedicating Officers, enters in procession, takes the Chair, and appoints his Micers.
- 3. The W.M., Wardens and Officers of the Halesowen Loan 15.5635 are assembled in the centre of the Lodge Room.
- 4. The Prov. G.D.C. and escort retire.
- 5. The Tyler announces the return of the escort rearing the Banner.
- 6. W.Bro. T.S. Wood, P.Prov.G.Reg., Donor, requests the R. W. Prov. Grand Master to receive the Banner for presentation and dedication.
- 7. The R. W. Prov. G. Master unveils the Banner and invites the Worshipful Master of Halesowen looge to relative it.
- 8. The Prov. Grand Chaplain produces the Dedication Prayer.

"O Lord our Heavenly Father, Archivect and Ruler of the Universe, who dost from Thy Throne pehold all dwellers upon earth: we beseech Thee to bless and hall we this Banner which we here dedicate as a symbol of our Mesonic fellowship, and to the honour and glory of Thy Most Holy Mane. Grunt to all who gather beneath its shadow, wisdom to teach, huminity to learn, and grace to fulfil their obligations. Pour down upon them, and upon the members of our fraterning, the continual dew of Thy Blessing that we may daily increase in love or Thee and of one another. And when earth's fitful day is past, grant unto us a happy passing and a glorious entry into Thy heavenly Temple where amid the company of thy faithful people we may shine like the stars for ever and ever."

12. Hymn:- "Now thank we all our God".
