Order of Procedure

- 5. The donor requests the R.W. Prov.G.Master to receive the Banner for presentation and dedication.
- 6. The R.W. Prov.G.Master unveils the Banner and invites the W.M. of the Lodge to receive the Banner.
- 7. The Acting Prov. G. Chaplain pronounces the Dedication Prayer.


