Now and henceforth for evermore.

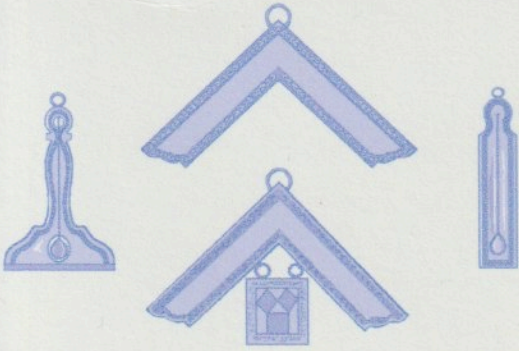
