The Presiding Officer, W.Bro. R. E. Whitlock, P.S.G.D., Assistant Provincial Grand Master, having entered in procession, takes the Chair and appoints the Officers.

OPENING HYMN

R.W.Bro. E. F. Hanson, J.P., LL.D. (Hon.), Provincial Grand Master, is announced and enters in procession.

The Consecrating Officer addresses the Brethren on the object of the meeting and calls upon the Chaplain to give...

THE OPENING PRAYER

Chan' (Omnes) "So mote it be".

The Director of Ceremonies addresses the Consecrating Officer.

The Consecrating Officer replies and gives directions.

The Petitioners of the New Lodge are ranged in order.

The Provincial Grand Secretary reads the Warrant.

The Consecrating Officer enquires of the Brethren of the New Lodge if they approve of the Officers named in the Warrant.

The Brethren signify their approval in Masonic Form.

The Consecrating Office: directs that the Lodge Board be uncovered.

THE CONSECRATION

during which the elements of Consecration are carried round the Lodge.

The Chaplain read Falm Ixxii, verse 16.

The Brothren sing:-

When once of old in Israel,
Our early Brethren wrought with toil,
Jehovah's blessings on them fell
In showers of Corn, and Wine, and Oil.

The Consecrating Officer scatters Corn - the symbol of Plenty and Abundance.

Musical Response (Omnes): "Glory be to God on high".

The Chaplain read Nehemiah, chap. x, verse 39.

The Brethren sing:-

When there, a shrine to Him alone
They built with worship, sin to foil,
On threshhold and on corner-stone,
They poured out Corn, and Wine, and Oil.

The Consecrating Officer pours Wine - the symbol of Joy and Cheerfulness.

Musical Response (Omnes): "Glory be to God on high".

The Chaplain read Exodus, chap. xxx, verses 26 and 26.

The Brethren sing:-

And we have come, fra ernal bands,
With joy, and pride, and prosperous spoil,
To honour Him with votive hands,
With streams of Corn, and Wine, and Oil.

The Consecrating Officer pours Oil - the symbol of Peace and Unanimity.

Musical Response (Orange): "Glery be to God on high".

The Petitioners are arranged around the Lodge Board, facing outwards.

The Chaplain reads Levicius, chap. ii, verse 13.

The Brethren sing:

Now o'er our work this Salt we shower, Emblem of Thy conservant power, And may Thy presence, Lord, we pray, Keep this our Temple from decay.

The Consecrating Officer sprinkles Salt - the symbol of Fidelity and Friendship.

Musical Response (Omnes): "Glory be to God on high".

THE CONSECRATING OFFICER DEDICATES THE LODGE

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE LODGE

It is the practice in the Province of Worcestershire for a Provincial Senior and Junior Warden to accompany the Provincial Grand Master his Deputy and Assistants, whenever on official Masonic Business within the Province. This includes all Installations, Centenaries. Banner Dedications, Golden Jubilees, etc. - some 130 plus occasions during each year. As it is not practicable for the two Wardens of the year to attend on all these occasions, past acting Wardens are called upon for a number of years to assist in carrying out these duties.

During these years a very close bond and friendship is forged between these brethren and it is to perpetuate this friendship and to unite these brethren with a common bond that Custos Lodge was proposed.

It will also provide an opportunity of paying tribute and showing appreciation to the more senior members by electing them to serve as Master and it will serve as a more formal chance to exchange views and discuss topics of local master is interest.
