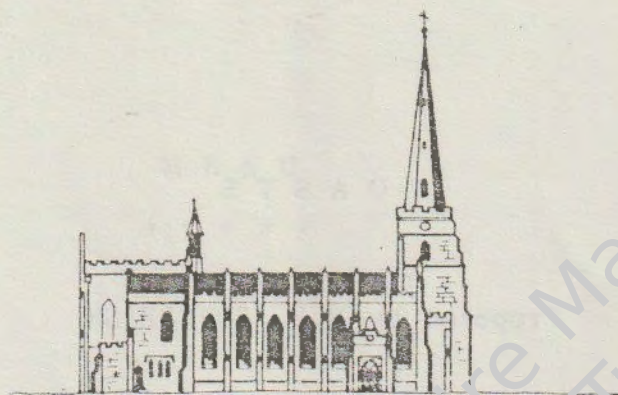

#### HISTORICAL NOTE ON THE ORIGIN OF OLD SWINFORD

King Eadred (946 — 955) made a grant of six Hides of land at Swineford over 1000 years ago. This land was bounded against Kingswinford, Kinfare and Redmore and effectively formed the area of Old-Swinford. This became the Parish of Oldswinford, of which Stourbridge was a part.

The Parish Church of St. Mary, Oldswinford, has been for many centuries the centre of Christianity and social life in Oldswinford. It is mentioned in the Domesday Book at a date of 1086 but was in existence long before that date.

The Regular Meetings of the Chapter shall be held on the first Thursday in February, April (Enthronement) and December.
