## THE FIRST GRAND PRINCIPAL

Today we are met to celebrate the 25th Anniversary of the Installation as the ME The First Grand Principal of His Royal Highness The Duke of Kent, KG. Although Supreme Grand Chapter has celebrated its 225th Anniversary, the 25th Anniversary of a First Grand Principal is still a rare occurrence. Only four of His Royal Highness's predecessors have achieved that distinction: HRH Augustus Frederick, Duke of Sussex, KG, from 1810 to 1843; Thomas, 2nd Earl of Zetland, KG, from 1844 to 1870; HRH Albert Edward, Prince of Wales, KG, (King Edward VII) from 1874 to 1901 and HRH The Duke of Connaught, KG, from 1901 to 1939.

The First Grand Principal was Exalted in the Westminster and Keystone Chapter No. 10 and subsequently was Installed as its First Principal. On his Installation as the MW The Grand Master he automatically assumed the office of First Grand Principal and was Installed into that office by the then Second Grand Principal, now ME Comp. the Rt. Hon. Earl Cadogan, *MC, DL*, Past Pro First Grand Principal, at the Convocation of Supreme Grand Chapter held on 8 November 1967.

The 25 years over which the First Grand Principal has presided have not been uneventful. The number of Chapters on the Register has risen from 2,736 in 1967 to 3,271 today, and the first Bi-centenaries of private Chapters were granted in 1969. Running throughout the period has been the subject of the ritual, leading to its revision and simplification in 1989. In the complex and arduous discussions on the ritual the ME The First Grand Principal has given the same leadership and support that he gave in the changes in the Craft. In congratulating him on achieving his Silver Jubilee we also express the hope that he will be given many years to continue his wise and benevolent rule within this Supreme Order of the Holy Royal Arch.
