Worcestershire, Warwickshire, Gloucestershire and Staffordshire.
Again these will be sprint races in "fat boats / coxed gigs" over 250m
or more.

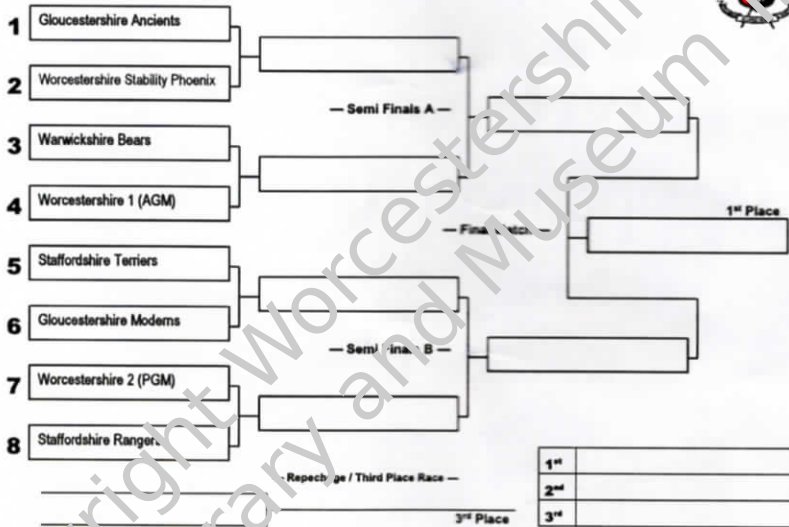

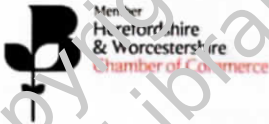
