**BYE-LAWS**

## BYE-LAWS

1.—This Lodge of Instruction shall be called the "Grosvenor Lodge of Instruction No. 1257" working under the sanction of the Grosvenor Lodge No. 1257.

2.—The meetings shall be held at The Phoenix Hotel, John Princes Street, Oxford Circus (or at such other place as the Brethren in Open Lodge may decide upon) on Wednesday evenings at 6.30 p.m. throughout the year, with the exception of the months of July and August.

3.—Any Subscribing Member of a regular Lodge desirous of becoming a member shall be proposed and seconded, and elected by a show of hands. The Candidate's full name and address, and the name and number of his Lodge must be given in writing to the Secretary at the time of proposal.

4.—The Joining Fee shall be 1/-, in addition to which Members shall pay 1/- for each attendance. Members may pay in advance an annual subscription of 15/- instead of the attendance fee. Visitors, who must be Subscribing Members of a regular Lodge, may be introduced by Members. The Visitor's Fee shall be 1/-.

5.—A Preceptor, Deputy Preceptors, Treasurer, Secretary, Assistant Secretary and Curator shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting on the last Meeting in June. All the above, together with two Members similarly elected, the Master of the Grosvenor Lodge and the Master of the Portcullis Lodge ex officio shall form the General Purposes Committee, with power to co-opt.

6.—The Accounts of the Lodge of Instruction shall be audited by two Auditors who, being Members of the Lodge of Instruction but not Members of the General Purposes Committee shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting.

The Audited Accounts of the previous session shall be presented to the Lodge of Instruction at the first meeting in October.

7.—The Committee of the Lodge of Instruction Library (four Members) shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting.

8.—The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the proceedings of the Lodge, and of all moneys received and disbursed. He shall also keep a list of Members with the date of their joining, and the names and numbers of their respective Lodges.

9.—The mode of working the ceremonies shall be in strict conformity with the recognised system of the Emulation Lodge of Improvement, and no discussion on the working shall be permitted while the Lodge is open for business.

10.—A Master for the ensuing meeting shall be elected weekly, and shall forthwith appoint his officers, and name the work. Should the Brother elected as Master or any Brother nominated for office be absent at the time of opening the Lodge, the Preceptor shall nominate another Brother to take the place of the absentee.

11.—At the meeting immediately preceding the regular meeting of the Grosvenor Lodge, the Worshipful Master or his nominee shall have the right of working, with his own officers, any ceremony or ceremonies he desires to rehearse for such regular meeting.

12.—Notice of Motion of any proposed alteration or addition to these Bye-Laws must be given in Open Lodge, and a copy in writing given to the Secretary. It shall be voted upon at the following Lodge Meeting, and confirmed at the next subsequent meeting.

13.—The ceremonies to be worked shall be according to the programme arranged by the Lodge of Instruction.
