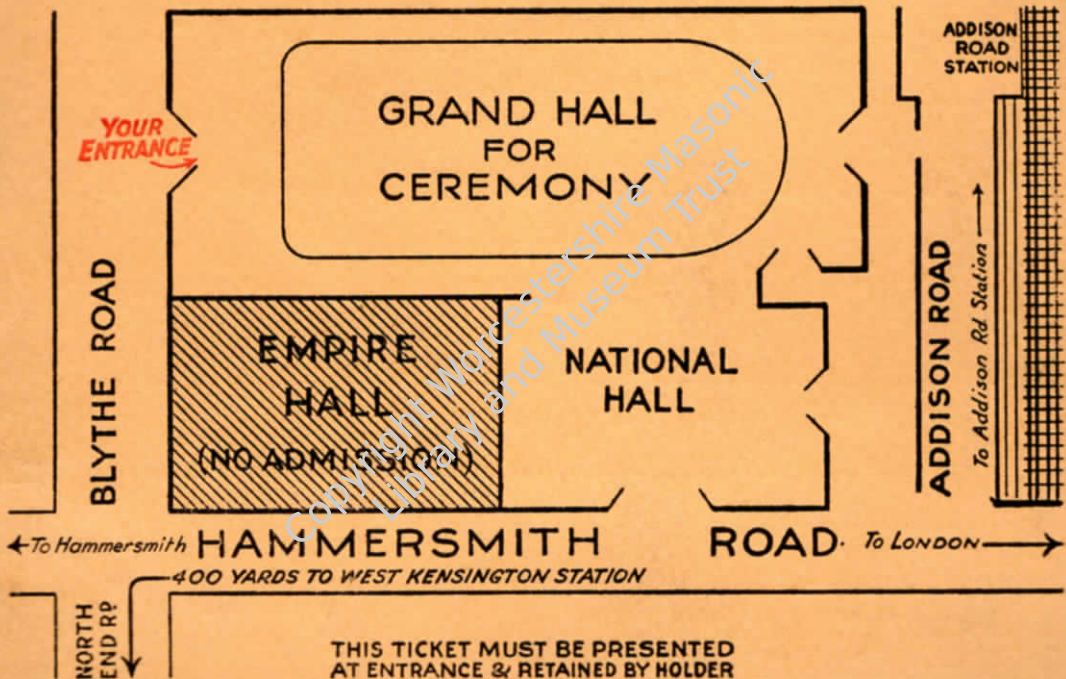

# Freemasons' Hospital and Nursing Home

## CEREMONY OF THE LAYING OF THE STONE OF DEDICATION FROM OLYMPIA, 19th MAY, 1932.

### Information for Brethren Attending.

- (1) Do not use your car if it can possibly be avoided. Traffic conditions are very difficult, and if you must use your car, please note that there is a one-way traffic round Olympia. Traffic approaching from the West causes the police less trouble than traffic approaching from the East.
- (2) Please note carefully the entrance named on the ticket (and indicated on the back thereof) by which alone you will gain admission. You will find your cloakroom accommodation near at hand, clearly marked with a colour corresponding to the colour of your ticket. There will be ample direction signs in the building showing the way to your seats.
- (3) Doors will be opened at 1.30 p.m. and closed at 2.40 p.m. All seats must be taken by 2.45 p.m. The seating arrangements will be clearly indicated by directions which will be posted in the building. All seats are *unnumbered* in small blocks. The number of the block is indicated on your ticket.
- (4) The Ceremony will commence at 3.10 p.m. for 3.15 p.m. The band of the Grenadier Guards will play during the assembling of the guests and for a short time after the Ceremony.
- (5) Grand Lodge Officers will wear full dress Masonic Clothing. All Brethren entitled to do so will wear Collars of their ranks as well as their Aprons. Black coats and white gloves will, of course, be worn.
- (6) All who are entitled to do so will greatly oblige by wearing the Commemorative Jewel of the Freemasons' Hospital, and ladies entitled to it will be doing the Board of Management a favour if they will kindly wear the Ladies' Special Memento.
- (7) *Brethren will please note that Olympia is not Tyled, as ladies are present.*
- (8) Brethren are earnestly requested not to move from their seats after the Ceremony until the Grand Lodge Procession has left the building.
- (9) If you are unable to use your tickets, please return them without delay.

## HOW TO REACH OLYMPIA.

Do not use your car if you can avoid it. If it is absolutely necessary to use it, please note that there is a one-way traffic around Olympia.

The access *by train* is:—

- (1) Via District Railway to West Kensington or Baron's Court Station (each 8 minutes' walk).
- (2) To Addison Road (from Earl's Court (District) or from Willesden Junction (L.M.S. Railway)) opposite Olympia. Turn to left on leaving the station on the Olympia side to reach Hammersmith Road or National Hall or balcony entrances. Straight ahead westwards to reach Blythe Road entrance.
- (3) By Central London Tube to Shepherd's Bush Station (15 minutes' walk).
- (4) To Hammersmith Broadway (Metropolitan and Great Western point)—10 minutes' walk from Olympia.  
By Bus Routes passing Olympia, or within 50 yards of it, or by bus or train to Hammersmith Broadway (10 minutes' walk), viz:—

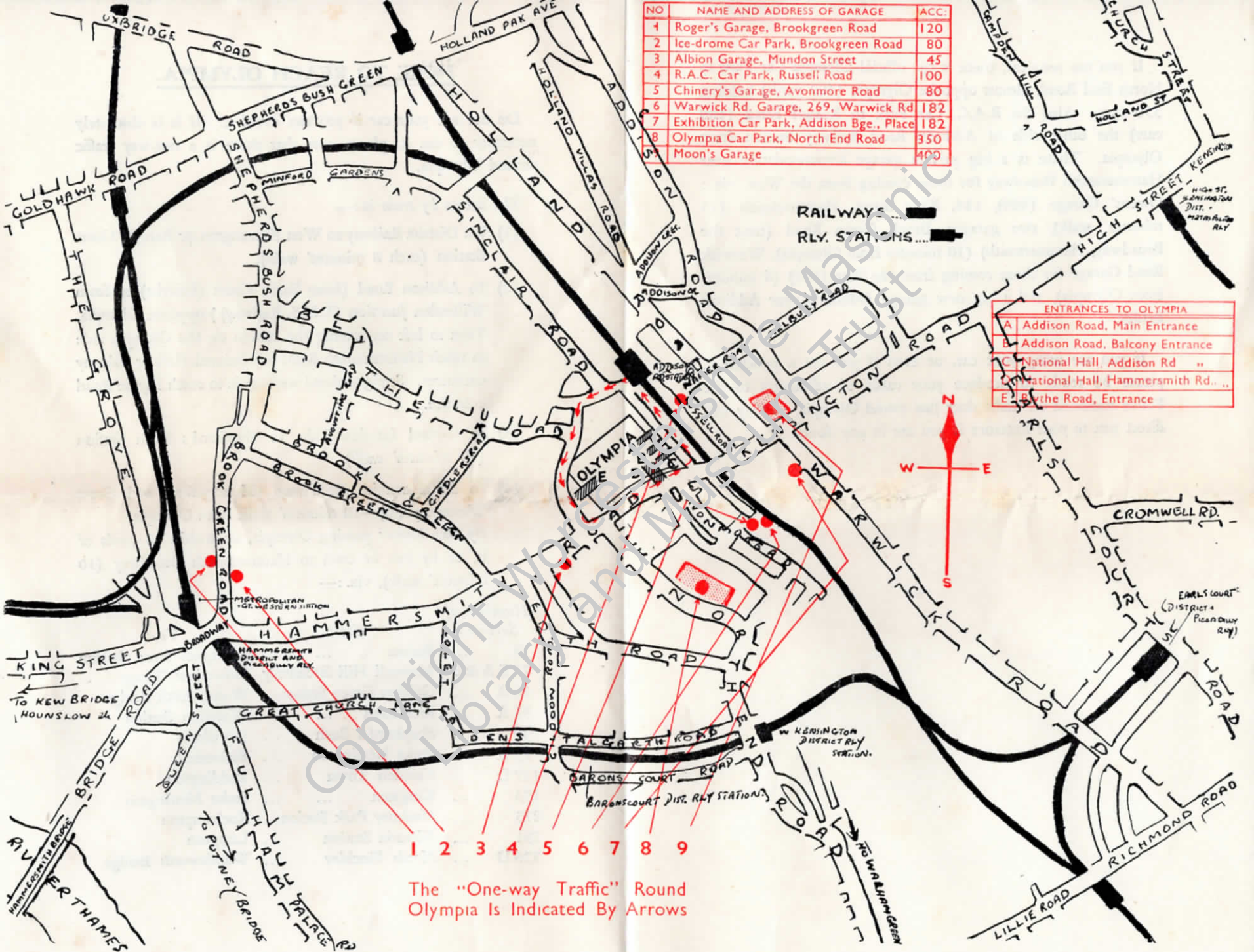
If you use your car, there is the official Olympia Car Park in North End Road, almost opposite Olympia (400 yards) holding 350 cars. Also the R.A.C. Car Park in Russell Road (100 cars) the other side of Addison Road Railway Station from Olympia. There is a big private garage accommodation near Hammersmith Broadway for those coming from the West, viz. : Owens' Garage (400), 134, King Street, Hammersmith (15 minutes' walk), two garages, Brook Green Road (next the Broadway, Hammersmith) (10 minutes from Olympia), Warwick Road Garage for those coming from the East (182) (4 minutes from Olympia), and a big new garage (Moon's) near Addison Bridge.

If you are using your car, or even if you are a pedestrian, please be ready to produce your cards of admission to the Police stationed on traffic duty just round Olympia, as they will direct you to your Entrance if you are in any doubt.
