And the other finds his best respect upon the checkered floor.

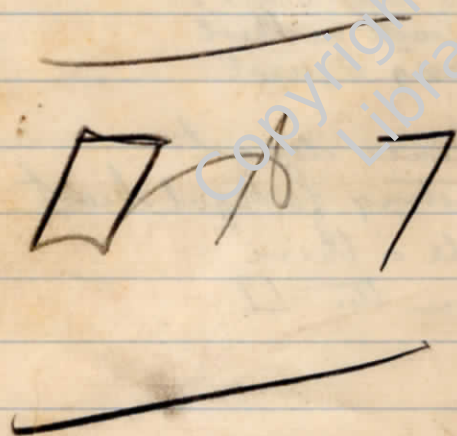
We part upon the O for the world must have its due
