inserted in their proper place :—*

Deputy Grand Director of Ceremonies,
Past Deputy Grand Director of Ceremonies,
Grand Standard Bearer,
Past Grand Standard Bearer.

9. *Last two lines, substitute installed, for he
has filled the office of.*

18. *Substitute All Grand Officers, except
Chaplains, Organist and Tyler for The Grand
Registrar.*

26. *Seventh line, after Lodge, insert, being
or having been Master of a Lodge.*

30. *Sixth line, after auditor, insert, who
shall be a Master Mason.*

*Insert, and annually appointed by Grand
Lodge, instead of appointed by the Grand
Master.*

41. *Fourth line, substitute an Installed
Master, for a Master Mason.*

52. *Seventh line, after shall, insert, by notice
to the Grand Secretary, or.*

54. *Page 19, first line, substitute in the judg-
ment of the Committee, for in his judgment.*

57. *Third line, after officers, insert, present and past, Deputy Provincial Grand Masters and Provincial Grand Secretaries.*

80. *Fourth and fifth lines, omit the Provincial or District Grand Stewards of the year with the object of including them amongst the present and past Provincial or District Grand Officers.*

80. *Sixth line, read and Wardens of and Past Masters of or in all Lodges.*

81. *Eighth and Ninth lines, omit in many respects, so as to confirm to Provincial and District Grand Masters the rank and power they at present possess.*

83. *After Eighth with line, insert a Provincial or District Grand Standard Bearer.*

92. *And be resident within the Province and a subscribing member to a Lodge therein.*

96. *Omit the paragraph, with the object of Provincial or District Grand Stewards being included in 94 with other Provincial or District Grand Officers.*

102. *Twelfth line, after initiated, insert, or who has joined from a Lodge not holding under the English Constitution.*

103. *Fifth line, after every, insert, annual meeting of.*

119. *Seventh line, after registered, insert, Master.*

119. *Page 43, seventh line, after A.B., insert, who has served the office of Warden in a regular warranted Lodge.*

124. *First line, substitute Country for Provincial or District et passim.*

136. *Sixth line, after Lodge, read the Treasurer or Tyler may.*

146a. *Insert new Article, giving Provincial or District Grand Masters power to send their Grand Officers to visit any Lodge.*

148. *Fourth line, after present, insert, after due examination.*

152. *Third line, substitute Country for Provincial or District*

160. *Third line, after Grand Master, insert, or the Provincial or District Grand Master.*

161. *Second line, insert, copy of the book of Constitutions and a.*

170. *First line, after shall, insert, keep a register of its members and.*

172. *Omit the paragraph.*

185. *Margin, insert Naval and.*

Fifth line, omit Military. Fifth line, after rank of a, insert, second class petty officer in the Navy, or a corporal in the Army.

186. *Add,* Every such joining member, if a Past Master, shall have the rank and position of a Past Master of the Lodge, ranking next after the Junior Past Master and the then Worshipful Master of such Lodge, providing he has not ceased subscribing to a Lodge for twelve months.

190. *Second line, substitute six for five. Page 68, after first paragraph, insert,* Provided that no such brother shall be so elected until he shall have resigned the position of serving brother for a period of two years

209. *Add,* And any Lodge failing to make due inquiry shall be liable to pay the arrears owing by such brother to the Lodge from which he has been excluded

292. *Add,* Chaplain, the open Bible, Director of Ceremonies, two rods in saltire, Organist, the lyre

302. *Second line, omit* during their period of office only, and then only in their own Provinces or Districts.

306. *Page 108, third and fourth lines, omit* while in office and in their own Provinces only.
