Consent was given for the removal of the Nene Lodge from Spa dirg to Long Sutton.

An expression of sympathy with the Rt. Hon. the Earl of Yarl orough was accorded by the Brethren, and the Prov. G. Master promised to communicate it.

Resolved that the Board of G. Purposes consider the propriety of closing the Yarborough Fund.

Resolved that an honorarium of £5 5s. be paid to the Prov. G. Secretary in respect of his past year's services, and that such payment be continued yearly for the future.

The D.C. obtained permission to bave Prov. C.S. Lothing repaired.
