Prince George, Duke of Kent (1902-42)

Initiated as on this summons, raised June 28, 1928. He was installed as Grand Master of the G.L of England on July 19, 1939, and was killed in an aeroplane accident in 1942.

Proposer:- Edward VIII (1894-1972), King in 1936 (later Duke of Windsor). Init. 2-5-1919 by the Duke of Connaught in the Household Brigade Lodge No. 2614. In 1936 he was made Grand Master of the G.L. of England.

Seconder:- George VI (1895-1952) King 1936-1952.

Init. Dec. 1919 in Navy Lodge and on his succession to the throne was installed as Past Grand Master of the U.G.L. of England.
