
By-Laws

In all respects the members of this Tabernacle shall abide by, and strictly conform to, the Regulations of the Grand College of the Holy Royal Arch Knight Templar Priests of Great Britain and Tabernacles Overseas.

1. The Tabernacle shall meet at the Masonic Hall, Churchfields, Bromsgrove, Worcestershire, on the first Saturday in the month of February, the third Saturday in the month of May and the second Saturday in the month of October in each year at such hour as the High Priest shall direct.
2. The High Priest and Treasurer shall be elected by ballot. The Outer Sentinel and two Auditors shall be elected by show of hands. All these at the regular meeting in May. The High Priest shall be installed at the regular meeting in October, when he shall appoint and invest the Officers.
3. The Treasurer shall collect, and receive, all monies, which he shall deposit in a Bank Account approved by and in the name of the Tabernacle. He shall pay all accounts and present his duly audited Statement at the Installation Meeting.
4. The admission fee, exclusive of regalia or Grand College Registration Fee, the annual subscription, the joining and re-joining fees shall be of such amounts as the Tabernacle shall from time to time decide by resolution after notice on the summons. The annual subscription shall be payable in advance at the May meeting. The dining fee shall be such as determined on the day of the meeting. A member in arrears of subscription for two years shall be liable for exclusion, after due notice.
5. Propositions for Candidates for admission, joining or re-joining must be in the hands of the Recorder not less than four weeks before the meeting at which the ballot is to take place, and particulars of each candidate shall appear on the summons to such meeting. Should one negative appear in the ballot box, the proposition shall be rejected, and cannot be renewed until twelve months have elapsed.
6. The custody or ownership of all property of the Tabernacle, of whatever nature, shall be vested in the Standing Committee, which shall consist of the High Priest, Past High Priests and Officers of the Tabernacle.
7. No motion, question, or proposition affecting the By-Laws, funds, or property of the Tabernacle shall be decided unless notice thereof shall have appeared in the summons convening the Tabernacle at which the same is to be considered.
8. All alteration or amendments must be approved by two-thirds of the members present and voting, and finally approved by the Grand Council of Grand College.


The above re-drafted By-Laws were approved in open Tabernacle on Saturday 21st May 2011
