The Grand Stewards of the Year.

The Master, Past Masters, and Wardens of the Grand Stewards Lodge, and the Masters, Past Masters, and Wardens of many other Lodges.

The Grand Lodge was opened in form and with solemn prayer.

The Minutes of the Quarterly Communication of the 5th June were read and confirmed.

The GRAND SECRETARY, by command of the Acting Grand Master, then read the following letter, which had been received from the Grand Lodge, Royal York of Friendship, at Berlin, and it was ordered to be entered on the Minutes, viz. :—

“ Berlin, 12th August, 1872.

“ Dear Sir and Very Worshipful Brother,

“ The revision of the Book of Constitutions of the Grand Lodge, ROYAL YORK ZUR FREUNDSCHAFT, having taken place nine years ago, a new revision was made this year. On this occasion the question of the initiation of Jews was
