BY-LAWS.

1. This Association shall be called The Royal Rose Lodge, No. 2565, Masonic Charities Association.

2. The object of the Association shall be to obtain for its members a Life-Subscribership or a Life-Governorship in one or more of the following :—

The Royal Masonic Institution for Girls,
The Royal Masonic Institution for Boys,
The Royal Masonic Benevolent Institution.
Also to collect donations for the Royal Masonic Hospital.

3. The Committee of the Association shall consist of a President, Vice-Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer and five members of the Association, five to form a quorum.

4. The Secretary shall keep a register of the names and addresses of all Members and records of the Association; he shall collect the Subscriptions and hand them to the Treasurer, who shall keep an account of all receipts and expenditure of the Association.

5. The Annual General Meeting shall take place during January of each year, at which meeting three auditors shall be elected to verify the accounts and present their report at that meeting.

6. The funds of the Association shall be deposited in a Bank to be selected by the Treasurer in the joint names of the President, Treasurer and Secretary, and no payments of any kind other than the Secretary's petty cash disbursements, shall be made except by cheque on the Bankers signed by two of the following—President, Treasurer and Secretary.

7. A joining fee of 2s. 6d. for each Life-Subscribership or Life-Governorship shall be paid, which shall be applied to the working expenses of the Association.

8. The Subscription shall commence from the date of joining, and shall be at the rate of Five Shillings per share per month, payable in advance.

9. All Subscriptions forwarded by post must be sent to the Secretary by a crossed P.O. or cheque made payable to 'The Royal Rose Lodge, No. 2565, Masonic Charities Association,' with the subscription card and stamped addressed envelope for return.

10. A Member may, with the assent of the Committee, transfer any Share to another Member, provided that the Share has not been allocated to any Steward's List or Institution.

11. When the Treasurer shall have in hand the sum of Five Guineas from Subscriptions, a Ballot shall take place, and the successful member, or his nominee, shall direct the Treasurer to pay the amount to the Institution selected. The receipt shall be held by the Treasurer until the Member has paid his Share in full.

12. The Ballots shall take place whenever possible on the evenings of the Mother Lodge Meetings, or whenever the Committee shall decide.

13. No Member whose Subscription is three months in arrear shall be allowed to participate in any Ballot.

14. No Member shall participate in a Ballot until he has paid eight months' Subscription, and shall not be again entered for a Ballot after having been successful in relation to that particular Five Guineas.

15. Any Member who shall fully pay up all Subscriptions due from him in respect of any Share before being successful in a Ballot shall be entitled to have Five Guineas paid on his behalf to the selected Institution out of the first monies in the hands of the Treasurer available for that purpose.

16. A Member shall within one month of gaining a Ballot sign a declaration in favour of one of the Institutions, failing which the amount to again be balloted for.

17. All sums paid by any Member whose Subscriptions are six months in arrear shall be forfeited to the Association unless the Committee otherwise determine.

18. If any Member die without having been successful in a Ballot, all his Subscriptions shall be returned to his legal representative (if desired) as soon as convenient.

19. Any question arising out of these By-Laws or between the Association and any Member thereof shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final.

20. No motion for amending these By-Laws shall be made unless notice in writing specifying the amendment proposed be deposited with the Secretary at least one month prior to the Annual General Meeting.
